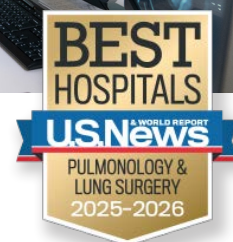


B-Read Services

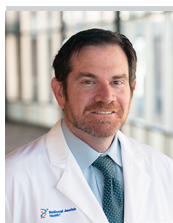

Services Highlights

- B-reads of chest X-rays and specialized interpretations of CT scans, on request from physician or other licensed health care provider (PLHCP)
- Interpretations completed within 10 business days of receipt
- Completion of International Classification of Pneumoconiosis reading sheet for CTs
- The B-read interpretation will be mailed to the PLHCP within 7 business days after completion. The PLHCP will assure that abnormal B-read findings are communicated to the individual who underwent chest imaging and that appropriate management is undertaken.
- B-Read Team supplies the Department of Health and Human Services Public Health Services form for Roentgenographic Interpretation.
