

Dr. Vamsi Guntur is a board-certified Professor of Clinical Medicine in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine at National Jewish Health (NJH) in Denver, CO. With over 18 years of experience managing various pulmonary disorders at the University of Missouri (MU) and NJH, she now focuses on obstructive lung diseases such as asthma and COPD. Her clinical expertise is complemented by collaborative a) pre-clinical research at MU College of Veterinary Medicine, and b) clinical/translational research at NJH. She continues her research as a team scientist at NJH Asthma Institute with several collaborators in severe asthma of varying phenotypes, airway microbiome and alterations in airway epithelium in obstructive lung diseases. She also serves as the Director of the Pulmonary Asthma Clinics.
