

Dr Nicholas Hartog specializes in pediatric and adult allergy and immunology at Helen DeVos Children's Hospital, a division of Corewell Health, where he serves as head of the Adult and Pediatric Primary Immunodeficiency Clinic. He is clinical associate professor at Michigan State College of Human Medicine.

His clinical interests focus on primary and secondary immunodeficiency but also include allergic rhinitis,

food allergy, and treatment of severe asthma. Dr Hartog has authored or coauthored >30 publications on immunodeficiencies, food allergy, and COVID-19. He is a member of the Clinical Immunology Society Education and Advocacy Committee.
